As part of our exploration, we will use the thoughts of theologians and mystics such as Eckhart, Chittister, Merton, Rohr to name a few who will help us have a clearer understanding of the road ahead.

Below is a brief explanation of how our first retreat will look on 1st February.

The first invitation of our retreat afternoon is to look at The Lost Art of Simplicity and Humility. With our busy lifestyles, it is easy to neglect the 'baggage of life' that we carry within us, which can confuse and lessen our spiritual journey. It is an invitation to do a 'spring clean' where we identify the 'attachments of life' that we have travelled with during our lifetime. Is it time to reflect on those attachments and make some perhaps hard decisions about whether they are worth hanging on to?

And ...

The second invitation of our retreat afternoon is to look at Attending to the Growth of God within us on our journey of discovery. Theologian Meister Eckhart called it 'tending to the birth within'. After looking at the 'attachments' we carry in the first session and being aware of their influence, we continue our own personal journey of spiritual discovery.

Imagine a seed has been planted in your soul and is just waiting to be nurtured and tended. That seed is the seed of God.
